

## **Director, Development - Job Description**

The individual in this role will be a critical player in the future success of NSF as we move into new and exciting territory, making an impact on this fight.

**Hours & Commitment:** Applicants should be able to offer a minimum of 20 hours a week, bringing energy, passion, commitment and determination to the role. Hours, roles & responsibilities can be adjusted for the right candidate based on expertise and personal situation. Compensation will depend on candidate qualifications.

## Roles & Responsibilities:

- Hold direct responsibility for fundraising & development (F&D).

- Help plan and execute fundraising and other development events.
- Work with the local community and local NSF Team to find corporate sponsors and negotiate involvement in events including potential vendor campaigns.
- Assist in and steward relationships with providers (UCSF, Kaiser, LPCH, etc.) as needed, identifying and pursuing related development opportunities.
- Work with NSF volunteer membership as well as outside volunteer groups as needed.
- Correspond with patient families with compassion, respect and understanding to further our reach and impact as it relates to fundraising and development.
- Coordinate on media / press as related to development and events.
- Collaborate with and support Founder in all areas to ensure NSF is positioned for growth & impact.

- Minimum of BA or BS Degree.
- Minimum 3-5 years in past management roles.
- Minimum 3-5 years experience in non-profit space.
- Fundraising and / or grant writing experience.
- Knowledge of / ability to navigate grant databases and / or research and identify suitable opportunities.

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with proven ability to lead a team, collaborate with, and inspire individuals while executing on plan.
